Kunshan City is located in the southeastern part of Jiangsu Province, between Shanghai and Suzhou, covering a total area of 931 square kilometers. Five expressways, including the Shanghai-Nanjing Expressway, run through the entire area, and the Beijing-Shanghai High-Speed Railway passes through the city. Shanghai Metro Line 11 extends to Huaqiao in Kunshan, and Suzhou Rail Transit Line 11 connects Suzhou and Shanghai. Kunshan has a long history and rich cultural heritage, with over 6,000 years of civilization and more than 2,000 years of city history. It is the hometown of renowned figures such as Gu Yanwu, Gui Youguang, and Zhu Bailu, and Zu Chongzhi once served as the county magistrate here. Kunqu Opera, known as the "master of all operas," originated here. The city is home to Zhouzhuang, China's first water town, and three other national historical and cultural towns. Kunshan has been ranked first among China's top 100 counties for 19 consecutive years.

In recent years, Kunshan has basically developed four major tourism sectors: ancient water towns, ecological resorts, rural experiences, and urban leisure. The city is gradually transitioning from single sightseeing tourism to a composite high-quality tourism model that includes sightseeing, leisure, vacation, conferences, and health activities. As a provincial all-for-one tourism demonstration zone, Kunshan currently has one national 5A-level tourist attraction, three 4A-level tourist attractions, three 3A-level tourist attractions, one Excellent International Rural Tourism Destination in China, three national characteristic scenic tourism towns, two national industrial tourism zones, one Jiangsu provincial industrial tourism zone, four key rural tourism villages of Jiangsu Province, and one study tourism demonstration base of Jiangsu Province.

Gu Yanwu (1613—1682)

Originally named Jiang, with the courtesy name Ningren, Gu Yanwu was a native of Qiandeng Town in Kunshan. He was a great thinker and patriotic scholar during the Ming and Qing dynasties, known to scholars as "Mr. Tinglin." His notable works include Daily Accumulation of Knowledge, The Book on the Benefits and Harms of Counties and States Under Heaven, and Tinglin Poetry Collection. His advocacy of the phrase "Everyone is responsible for his country's rise or fall" became a powerful and



Gui Youguang (1506—1571)

Known by the courtesy names Xifu and also Kaifu, with the pseudonyms Zhenchuan and Xiangji Sheng. A native of Yushan Town in Kunshan, he was a renowned essayist of the Ming dynasty. His notable works include Xiangjixu an, Collection of Zhenchuan, and A Collection of Articles on Water Conservancy in Taihu Basin.



Zhu Bailu (1627—1698)

Born Yongchun with the courtesy name Zhiyi, Zhu Bailu was a native of Yushan Town in Kunshan. He was a famous Neo-Confucianist and educator. His works include Master Zhu's Maxims for the Home, The Collection of Humble Reflections, and Commentaries on the Great Learning and the Doctrine of the Mean.

II. National Key Cultural Relics Protection Units

Chuodun Site

Located in Chuodun Village, Bacheng Town, Chuodun Site covers an area of approximately 350,000 square meters and has unearthed over 1,000 artifacts.

Yuyan Hall

Yuyan Hall, originally named "Yishun Hall" and also known as "Zhang Hall," is located on Beishi Street, Zhouzhuang Town. It is situated to the east and faces west, covering a construction area of 1,884 square meters. It was first built during the Zhengtong period of the Ming Dynasty (1436—1450).

Tomb and Former Residence of Gu Yanwu

covers about 42,370 square meters and includes the living area, Gu Yanwu ancestral hall, Gu Yanwu tomb, and Gu Garden.

Qinfeng Pagoda

Located on the west bank of Shangshupu in Qiandeng Town, Qinfeng Pagoda has a total height of 39.5 meters. It was originally built in the second year of the Tianjian period of the Southern Liang Dynasty (503) and rebuilt in the first year of the Dazhong

Jingye Hall

Jingye Hall, also known as "Shen Hall," is located on Nanshi Street, Zhouzhuang Town. It sits to the east and faces the west, originally constructed in the seventh year of the Qianlong period of the Qing

I. Zhouzhuang Ancient Town

Zhouzhuang is among the first batch of 5A-level tourist attractions in China and one of the top ten most beautiful towns in the world. It features 14 ancient bridges built during the Yuan, Ming, and Qing dynasties, over 800 households of original residents building houses along the river, and 800,000 square meters of Ming and Qing architecture, exuding the charm of a water town with small bridges and flowing

II. Jinxi Ancient Town

Jinxi Ancient Town is a water town in Jiangnan with a history of over 2,500 years, known as the "Hometown of Chinese Folk Museums." A stream flows through the town, flanked by peach and plum trees. Morning and evening glows scatter across the river, the entire stream

III. Qiandeng Ancient Town

Known as "Golden Qiandeng," it is the hometown of the patriotic scholar Gu Yanwu and the birthplace of Kunqu Opera founder Gu Jian. The beautiful water town features stone-paved streets, ancient residential buildings, and the Qinfeng Pagoda. The town boasts a long history of Liangzhu culture, opera culture, and religious culture.

IV. Tinglin Garden

Tinglin Garden is a national 4A-level tourist attraction with a long history. Surrounded by winding water, it has a single prominent peak 80.8 meters above sea level, with a circumference of 1.5 kilometers, making it a rare urban mountain forest in Jiangnan. Apart from its beautiful scenery and profound cultural heritage, the garden also houses the three treasures of Kunshan—Kun Stone, Eight Immortals Flower, and Twin Lotus. Renowned garden expert Chen Congzhou praised it as "Jiangnan gardens are the best in the world, with a significant portion of the spring scenery on Yufeng Hill."

V. Bacheng Yangcheng Lake Scenic Area

This area consists of Bajie Garden and Bacheng Old Street. Bajie Garden is divided into themed zones such as the "Chinese Crab Path' main tour axis, "Crab Garden Spring and Autumn," and "Moon Reflection Pond." It is a comprehensive ecological leisure venue centered around water and crabs, offering tourism, leisure, health, and shopping experiences. Bacheng Old Street is known as the "Kunqu Opera Old Street," featuring museums and exhibition halls focused on Bacheng's historical and cultural heritage, studios of Kunqu Opera artists, and a Kunqu Opera-themed leisure district. It also includes Kunqu Opera performance stages, specialty dining, guesthouses, and shopping areas.

VI. Urban Ecological Forest Park

Covering a total area of about 3,000 acres, this large public theme park integrates urban regional environmental improvement, biodiversity conservation, leisure tourism, healthy activities, and science education. The park features several distinctive attractions, including Science Experience Area, Herb Garden, Crabapple Garden, Rose Garden, Rainwater Garden, Leisure Lawn, Wild Duck Beach, Lotus Pond, Plant Maze, Cedar Waterway, and Butterfly Flower Valley.

III. The Three Treasures of Kunshan

Kun Stone

Found in Ma'anshan, Kunshan, Kun Stone is renowned for its delicate and translucent appearance, also known as Linglong Stone, Qiao Stone, or Jade Stone. It is celebrated alongside Lingbi Stone, Taihu Stone, and Ying Stone as one of "China's Four Famous Stones."

Eight Immortals Flower

The Eight Immortals Flower is flat in shape, with a cluster of golden-yellow stamens in the center surrounded by eight white flowers, resembling a jade plate holding osmanthus. The Eight Immortals Flower tree in Tinglin Garden is over 300 years old, making it the oldest of its kind in the country.

The twin lotus, also known as the Thousand-Stamen Lotus and the Thousand Petal Lotus, has been cultivated in Kunshan for over 600 years. It symbolizes good fortune, auspiciousness, and true love. The Twin Lotus is a rare variety of the Thousand Petal Lotus, blooming without producing seed pods, making it extremely difficult to


