CAREER REPORT



As of January of 2026, a total of 25 students graduated from Duke Kunshan University's Master of Science in Global Health program. Within 6 months of graduation, **100%** of students entered the workforce or pursued further education. Among them, 17 graduates were employed in various sectors including healthcare, pharmaceuticals, consulting, finance, and education; 5 advanced to doctoral programs at prestigious universities, both in China and abroad; and 3 graduates pursued flexible employment.

During their time at DKU, the 2025 cohort actively engaged in fieldwork and professional practice. They conducted on-site research in multiple countries and cities, including China, Cambodia, Vietnam, Nepal, Singapore, Türkiye, and Switzerland, and participated in both in-person and remote internships in the healthcare sector. They also participated in on-site and remote internship programs, which expanded their career choices. We extend our best wishes to the 2025 graduates and look forward to their continuous progress in their career and education journey.

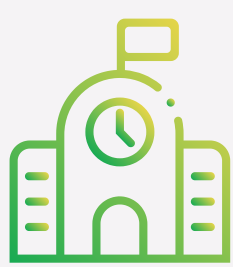

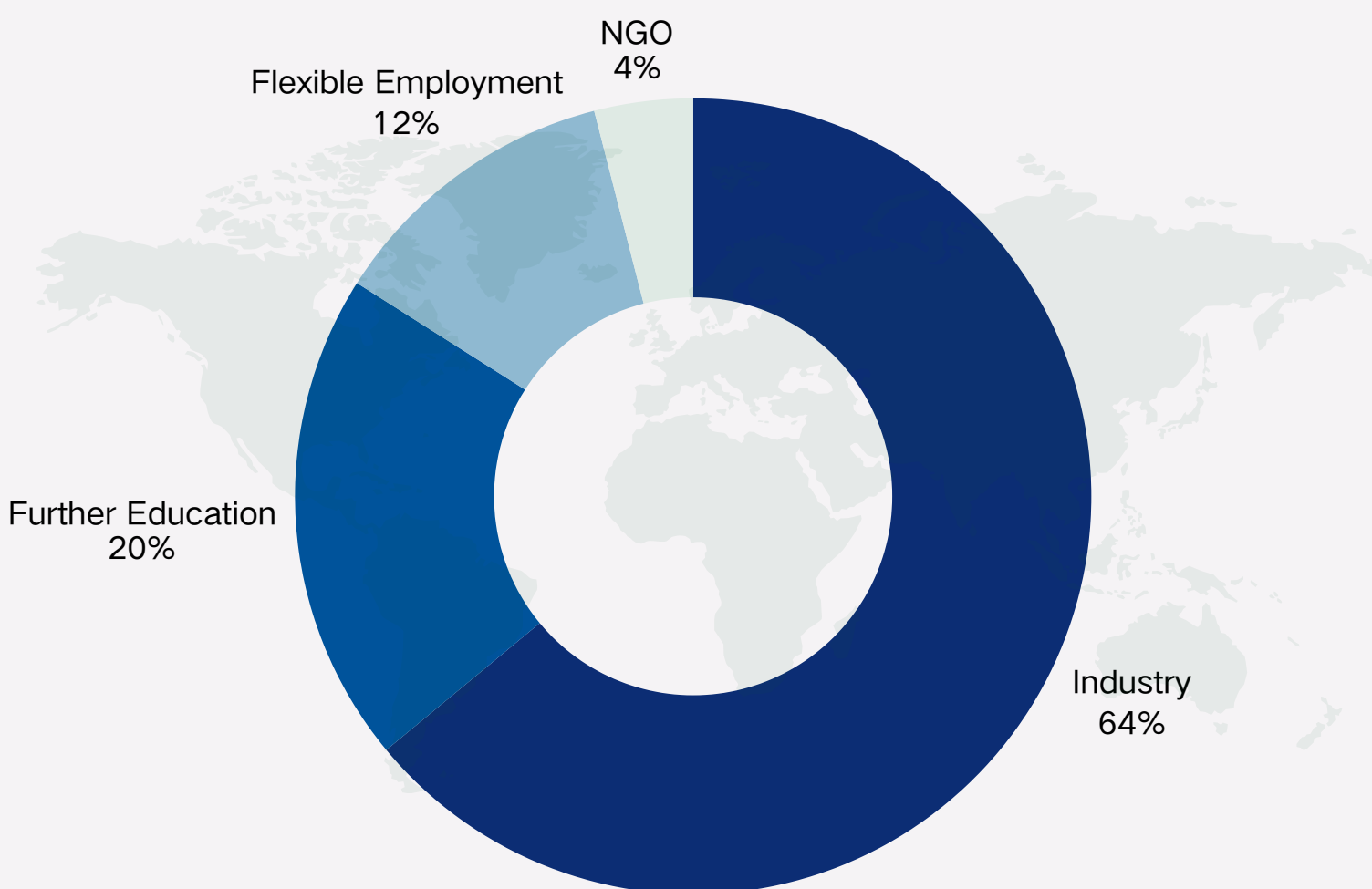

About Duke Kunshan University



Duke Kunshan University, jointly established by Duke University in the United States and Wuhan University in China, was officially approved by the Chinese Ministry of Education in September 2013 and is located in Kunshan, Jiangsu Province, China. As a high-level Sino-American cooperative university, Duke Kunshan University's mission is to build a high-level research university rooted in China and characterized by a liberal arts education. The university is committed to helping students from around the world pursue meaningful and successful journeys. By providing top-tier interdisciplinary undergraduate and graduate education, the university lays a solid foundation for students to grow into leading talents in various professional, academic, and social fields worldwide. Currently, the university has 7 research centers, 19 teaching and research laboratories, 14 undergraduate majors, and 5 graduate programs.

About the MSc-GH Program



The Master of Science in Global Health program at Duke Kunshan University was established in 2014. Drawing on the faculty expertise, experience, and academic resources of the Duke Global Health Institute, the program supports students in conducting research and engaging in practice on a global scale. Over the course of one and a half to two years of study, students are awarded a Master of Science degree conferred by Duke University and become part of its global alumni network. The program places strong emphasis on cultivating students' cross-cultural communication skills, their ability to translate theory into practice, and their leadership capacity. Its interdisciplinary training model provides students with diverse and attractive career pathways. Since its inception in 2014, the program has graduated a total of 109 students across 10 cohorts. Approximately 70% of graduates have pursued careers in healthcare institutions, international organizations, or pharmaceutical and biomedical enterprises, while nearly one-quarter have continued their studies at research institutions.
