
















Duke Kunshan University

Duke Kunshan University (DKU), located in Kunshan, Suzhou, Jiangsu Province. DKU is a non-profit Sino-Foreign Cooperative University approved by the Chinese Ministry of Education in September 2013 and founded by Duke University and Wuhan University, and operates as an independent legal entity. DKU began offering master's degree programs in 2014 and welcomed its first cohort of four-year undergraduate students in the fall of 2018, marking the commencement of its undergraduate education. As of May 2024, the university has graduated three classes, totaling 774 undergraduate students.

DKU upholds Duke University's philosophy of "Knowledge Serves Society" and integrates Wuhan University's educational principle of "Pursuing Truth and Innovation." With the mission of "Serving Truth and Justice, Society and the Nation," DKU aims to build a high-level research university rooted in China, characterized by liberal arts education. It is dedicated to helping students from around the world pursue meaningful and accomplished lives.

DKU offers students the same high-quality education and academic experience as Duke University. The undergraduate curriculum is based on the principles of liberal arts education, reflecting Duke's educational ethos. The interdisciplinary course design and teaching methods encourage students to tackle real-world problems and enhance teamwork, and provides them with opportunities to explore their personal development and strengthen academic capabilities. Upon successful completion of their studies, students receive degrees from both Duke University and Duke Kunshan University. This educational model equips students with problem-solving skills and the ability to apply their knowledge effectively, fostering broad inquiry, critical thinking, and practical application.
