

Shared Experience

Our unique Common Core courses bring students from different academic areas together in small class settings, often leading to robust, thought provoking discussions.



Applied Knowledge

Courses are interrelated and interdisciplinary within and beyond your major. Learn to view complex issues through multiple lenses and devise solutions to real-world problems in student/faculty teams from across the academic spectrum.

Block Schedule

We divide the conventional semester into two seven-week blocks. In each block, you will complete two to three focused courses. Students take classes four days a week – Monday to Thursday.





Signature Work

After choosing a topic in the second year, you will work toward a Signature Work project to showcase the knowledge you've accumulated over your four years, drawing on coursework, research, internships, community-based fieldwork, study abroad experience, and other activities.




FLEXIBLE PROGRAM


Research


DKU QUEST offers the opportunity to explore China, taking students on excursions to various destinations across the country. The program aims to provide a unique travel experience for students.
